- Number of scholarships: 60
- **Profiles:** Tourist guides and students
- Academic, volunteering and cultural activities:
 - 15 hours a week of Spanish
 - 10 hours a week of volunteering activities

General schedule

- March May: Call and selection procedures

New components

- Spanish certification exam: Applied at the end of the course, will provide the scholars with an international support of their language sufficiency.
- **Internationalization contest**: Two Colombian universities will be awarded with a week trip to one East Asian country to advance in the implementation of its internationalization strategy. *Component in process of development.
- Short Spanish course in East Asian countries: The Government of Colombia is exploring the possibility of generating alliances with universities from China, Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam or the Philippines to bring five (5) Spanish Colombian professors who teach a Spanish course for approximately 2 months. *Component in process of development.
