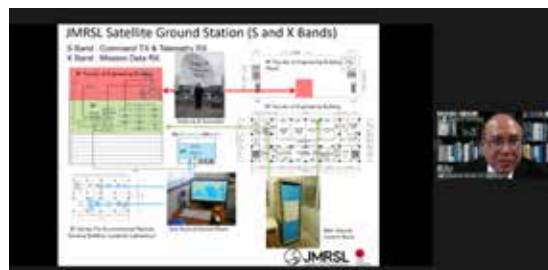

The UMY Information Security System has been recertified to ISO 27001:2013

The information security system of Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta (UMY) has again been awarded ISO 27001:2013 certification by the Information System Institute (LSI),

and the certificate was handed over on Wednesday (23/02) at the AR Fachrudin A Building. When contacted by phone, Wahyudi, Head of Information System Office of UMY, explained that the certification obtained was the latest series certification. "ISO 27001:2013 is the most recent ISO 27000 series certification icon, released in 2013", he said

He further mentioned that ISO 27001 is an international standard for Information Security Management Systems (SMKI) that offers a general description of what an organization or agency must do to apply the concept of information security and is valid until 2024.

He also stated that these efforts were made to aid in the improvement and maintenance of UMY's quality. "UMY aspires to establish information security as a higher education institution. "We continue to increase the quality of UMY in terms of information security with this certification", Wahyudi said.

Wahyudi also claimed that preparing for this certification took at least a year. "We prepared for a year by preparing related documents, compiling documents according to ISO standards, and making sure they were complete.

Then, putting in place a security procedure and managing security in accordance with these standards, which we will continue to enhance, and the audit is conducted by an impartial institution with no unfavorable findings", Wahyudi explained.

Wahyudi hopes that, in the future, the management of information systems will be even better due to this ISO certification. "It is hoped that with the latest ISO certification, the management of the information system will be even better, and that it will continue to be improved in line with ISO standards", he said.
