UMY Collaborate with De La Salle University on Double Degree Program!

Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta (UMY) is expanding even more globally. For this opportunity, UMY collaborates with De La Salle University (DLSU) from the Philippines for the double degree program. The MoU signing was held on Monday (13/2) in the Philippines.

It was signed by the Rector of DLSU, Br. Bernard S. Oca FSC and Prof. Dr. Achmad Nurmandi, M.Sc., the Vice Rector of Cooperation and International Affairs UMY. This double degree program is targeted at UMY's International Relations Program and DLSU's Southeast Asian Studies,

UMY's Government Studies and DLSU's Political Science, and UMY's Communication Science with DLSU's Communication. Since 2015, UMY has worked several times with DLSU including student exchange, staff exchange, and research collaborations.

This time, the agreement is stepped up by adding a double degree program which will be started next year with admission will be throughout 2023. Meanwhile, for the DLSU students, the dual degree program will be started on September 2023.

Idham Badruzaman, Ph.D., the Head of the International Relations Office of UMY explained that UMY provides several facilities that the double degree students will get, "UMY provides dorms and tuition-free during the double degree program in DLSU".



The double degree program will be started on the 4th, 5th, and 6th semester at the DLSU and students will be back to UMY in the 7th semester to finish their studies. "Students that will apply for this double degree need to pass all the subjects taken in the 1st-3rd semester.

Those who are interested in this program also need to take English skills. For the selection will be processed by each department and the results will be sent to Cooperation and International Affairs UMY." Idham added.

Prof. Dr. Achmad Nurmandi, M.Sc., stated that the Double Degree Program aims to increase the competitiveness of UMY students. "With two degrees from UMY and DLSU, students are expected to have more value to compete in the future. We hope that many students will take part in this program".
