## UMY Empowers Staff with Legal Drafting Skills in Recent Workshop



**O**n Thursday (19/10), the Office of Cooperation and International Affairs of Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta (OCIA UMY) hosted a Legal Drafting Workshop at the Pascasarjana Building. The workshop aimed to train all the academic staff from all departments and institutions on how to properly draft a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), Memorandum of Agreement (MoA), and Implementation Agreement (IA).

This workshop is conducted annually to ensure that legal documents drafted by academic staff adhere to applicable

rules and laws, thereby preventing future unintended events. Approximately 91 participants successfully completed the training.

Dr. Danang Wahyu Muhammad, SH., M.Hum., as the Head of the Bureau of Legal Affairs of UMY, is the main speaker for the agenda and presented the materials for legal drafting. Danang emphasized the importance of understanding the fundamentals of drafting a legal document, stating, "It is essential to understand how to properly draft an MoU, MoA, and IA. As it would also ease everyone's responsibilities and speed up the review process."

After delivering an explanation regarding the legal drafting, the workshop moved on to the overview session by demonstrating a sample agreement and IA drafts. Through this workshop, it is hoped that all the academic staff who are responsible for the legal drafting will gain a greater understanding of how to write the correct and appropriate legal drafting for MoU, MoA, and IA.



## Fostering the Collaboration with Dutch institutions, UMY participated in WINNER 2023

For this year, under the theme “Enhancing Knowledge Connectivity of Research and Education between Indonesia and the Netherlands for Regional Impact”, the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in Jakarta, Nuffic Neso Indonesia, the Indonesian Academy of Young Scientists (ALMI), the National Research and Innovation Agency (BRIN), the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences (KNAW), and the Dutch Research Council (NWO) hosted the event.



On October 10, as part of the WINNER 2023 kickoff, UMY participated in the Matchmaking Event at the Century Park Hotel in Jakarta to connect with universities from the Netherlands. dr. Maria Ulfa, MMR, Ph.D., as Head of the Cooperation Division of the Office of Cooperation and International Affairs UMY, represented UMY. Throughout the entirety of the Matchmaking Event, in-depth discussions on the potential for collaboration between UMY and Dutch universities took place.



Following the successful completion of the Matchmaking Event, the event continued with the opening ceremony and seminars concentrating on the academic development of Indonesia and the Netherlands. In the meantime, the campus exhibitions are conducted via the website Hopin. Thus, the exhibition was conducted simultaneously for 24 hours without interruption.

Promoting UMY to students in the Netherlands and connecting with new potential partners from the Netherlands has been a fantastic opportunity for UMY. It was hoped that it would make students in the Netherlands aware of and interested in UMY, while also fostering cooperation between UMY and universities in the Netherlands, such as Hanze University of Applied Sciences and Vrije University Amsterdam.
